MADEIRA FLOWER FESTIVAL

Between May 5th and 8th, under the theme “The flower that I chose” is held another edition of the Madeira Flower Festival, this year celebrated in the peak of the spring season.

As from May 5th all attentions are drawn to the central area of Avenida Arriaga, in downtown Funchal, where is held the Flower Market; in this same area it’s possible to witness the production of flower sculptures produced by locals.

At the Largo da Restauração and until May 10th is also worth paying a visit to the Flower Exhibition and witness in loco the art of constructing traditional floral carpets.

On Saturday morning, May 7th, thousands of children symbolically place a flower on the so-called “Wall of Hope” appealing for world peace. The wall’s set up ends with a release of pigeons and a special performance by a group of children.

The highlight of this festival takes place on Sunday, May 8th at 4p.m. with the Great Flower Parade. Several participant groups, beautifully dressed, with magnificent and detailed allegoric cars decorated with many different varieties of local flowers at the sound of exquisitely selected music will entertain locals and visitors throughout the main streets of Funchal.
