Gardens of the World: technical and managerial skills

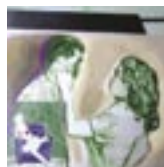

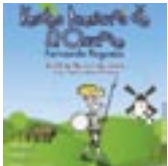

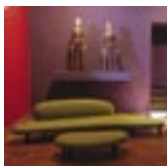
