ATLANTIC ROOTS FESTIVAL

The Municipal Garden of Funchal welcomes once again the Atlantic Roots Festival, the oldest festival of world music in Portugal.

This year, a regional film production opens the Festival on July 25, with the screening of "Intangible Symphony". A production by Tiago Pereira on traditional Madeiran music, preceding three days of diversified musical performances.

The festival is held, for the first time, under different themes. On July 26, it takes off under the theme "30 years of Songs" with Zeca Medeiros, followed by the mythical Tito Paris with rhythms and sounds from Cape Verde Island. For the next day, it will be possible to feel the atmosphere of a different musical genre under the "Tribal Dance" thematic with the groups: *Raízes Omiri* and Olive Tree Dance.

"Madeira Nights" is the theme chosen to close this year's edition with performances of two well-known regional groups: Encontros da Eira and Xarabanda

Good reasons not to miss this 13th edition of the Atlantic Roots Festival.

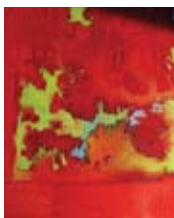

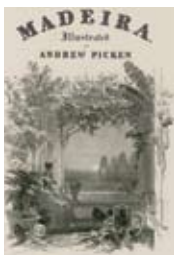

A selection of works that reflects the opening of the arts and of its different significances and readings, activating emotional states of cultural translation in its various perspectives. Having in mind the different aspects of the learning and experiencing processes of each artist's own world, the development of their way of thinking, the creation in a collective way of numerous reading possibilities of everyone's artistic expressions, its symbolisms and meaning.

It is essentially about experiencing all type of rupture and transgression that leads each artist to propose something, but always as of their own artistic criteria.

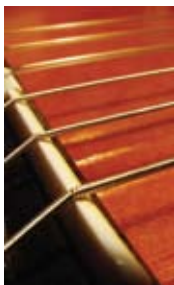

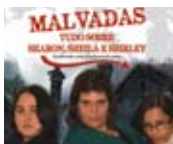
