1st International Encounter of Traditional String Instruments of the Macaronesia



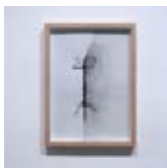
On May 23rd and 24th Funchal will be hosting the 1st International Encounter of Traditional String Instruments of the Macaronesia. Having as reference the string instruments traditional from each region, such as the Canary Islands (“timple”), Cape Verde (“cavaquinho”), the Azores (“viola da terra”), Madeira (“rajão”, “braguinha”, “Madeiran viola” and “viola de arame”) and mainland Portugal (Portuguese guitar), during two days issues related to their historic background, production and teaching methods will in discussion.

Furthermore, a series of concerts will take place, among which, we point out the performances by Antonio Chaínho and Carla Sousa.

This initiative is organised by the Madeiran cultural association Encontros Eira and is part of the Funchal 500 Years celebrations.

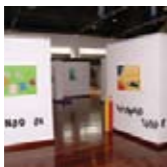

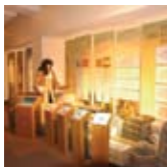
