Flower Festival



Once again the City of Funchal celebrates spring, honouring the main symbol of its uniqueness: flowers.

Within the festivities of the International Year of Biodiversity, the theme for 2010's Flower Festival is "Earth", recalling the great importance of this element for the planet's balance.

The events take off on April 15th with the opening of the Flower Market at Avenida Arriaga's Central Square, followed by the Flower Exhibition at Largo da Restauração and the creation of delicate floral carpets along the main streets of the city.

On Saturday morning, hundreds of children participate in the Children's Parade, placing a flower at the symbolic "Wall of Hope", in Praça do Município. On Sunday downtown Funchal welcomes the Grand Flower Parade.

This year the Flower Festival carries a deeper meaning: the rebirth of the City of Funchal and a start over since the storm that struck the Island on February 20th.

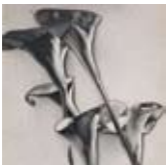

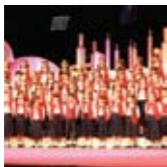

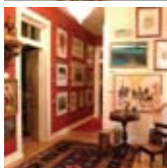
