FORENSIC SCIENCES IN THE LIMELIGHT

From 14th to 17th September 2011, the *19th Triennial Meeting of the International Association of Forensic Sciences (IAFS)* will be held in Funchal, together with the *9th Triennial Meeting of the World Police Medical Officers (WPMO)*, and the *5th Meeting of the Mediterranean Academy of Forensic Sciences (MAFS)*. This joint meeting will be preceded by workshops that will take place between 12th and 14th September.

The conference main theme will be *Global International Cooperation in Forensic Sciences*, cooperation that is essential for a forensic investigation ever more qualified and for a better administration of justice. This joint meeting is aimed at all those who, directly or indirectly, are involved in the forensic expert activity (police investigators, forensic experts and forensic experts, lawyers, judges, responsible for forensic investigation services, etc.). Although the official language of this event is English, there will be rooms for the presentation of free communications in Spanish, French and Portuguese.

The Pestana Casino Park Hotel and the Madeira Casino Auditorium will host these events, where all areas of the forensic sciences will be open to discussion and analysis to participants from more than 80 different countries.

Columbus Festival

The festival was first held in 2000 aiming to launch a cultural tourism offer of quality on the island of Porto Santo. Once again, from September 15th to 17th the island celebrates the navigator. The festival pays a tribute to Christopher Columbus, who resided in the island, recreating the historical period and involving the city center in an sixteenth century environment that always enchants locals and visitors.

The festival programme includes a 16th century market, the arrival of Columbus and a welcoming committee lead by Bartolomeu Perestrelo, the first Donatory-Captain of Porto Santo, an outdoor supper, a military detachment on the island by Moorish pirates and Castilian troops, theater performances and a wide range of street entertainment throughout the days. The organization encourages locals and tourists to take the part in this celebration providing costumes to all of those who wish to feature period characters, giving an extra authenticity to the event.

Portuguese Tiles Exhibition



The exhibit results from a private collection by David Feliciano and Graciete Roberts. Open at the Solar do Ribeirinho, in Machico, until September 30th, it reflects the first national experience on the complexity of the tiles' phenomenon in Portugal.

It's an opportunity to appreciate polychromatic composition tiles that use themes from the popularly and well-known pattern of the pine-cones or scads or cones with the particularity of its black outlined decoration.

The typology of a "single copy tile" is visible in two manor-houses of the Porto da Cruz Parish: in the outer walls of the traditional wooden porch of the Quinta dos Leais, and in the handrail of the staircase that leads to the second floor of the Solar do Engenho.

Over the past decade archaeological excavations in the urban area of Machico have identified other polychromatic series dated from the second half of the 17th century. A great majority comes from the Solar do Ribeirinho and includes some examples similar to the wall sets which were discovered in 80's.

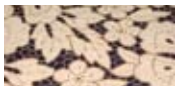
