Once again, Funchal is staging an amazing event not only visually but also the aroma of “The Flower Festival”. It takes place between the 19<sup>th</sup> and the 22<sup>nd</sup> of April under the theme, “From Madeira - One Flower for Peace”. This Festival started in 1979 and it is a homage to the local flowers and a continuity to Madeira’s real traditions, which changes the city for several days in a huge stage where a number of artistic and cultural events take place. Besides, the “flower wall”, “the wall of hope” and the big Flower parade, floral carpets are laid in the heart of the city. There are also classical music and traditional concerts and there is a flower exhibition which can be visited in “Largo da Restauração” and the Flower market along the “Avenida Arriaga.”
