The Department of Cultural Affairs has sought to settle its mission of cultural promotion, always without failing to ensure each cultural agent's area of action throughout the Region, either public or private, enabling the existence of an entertaining and cultural calendar of events, above the ratio that a population as ours generally has access to. Still, a complementary task has been engaged on regularly disseminate such events, in order to gain audiences and form new publics, simplifying the access of media to information sources and, consequently, highlighting, promoting and placing in evidence all cultural agents who operate in the Region. Celebrating five years of non-stop editions the Cultural Agenda's layout has proved to be effective for the purposes anticipated. It is also the most visible aspect of the ongoing institutional collaboration, which along with other ways of promotion, provided by new information and communication technologies, emphasizes all cultural events offered to an increasingly present and demanding audience.

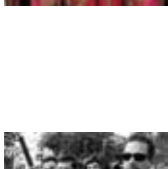

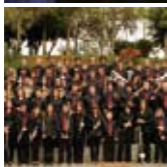
