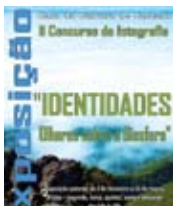

WORLD THEATRE DAY

On the 27th of March is celebrated the World Theatre Day, an anniversary established in 1961, in Paris, by the International Theatre Institute (ITI). This day symbolizes the origins of theater and its importance to society by expressing tragedy and comedy, through speech, feelings, thoughts and moods.

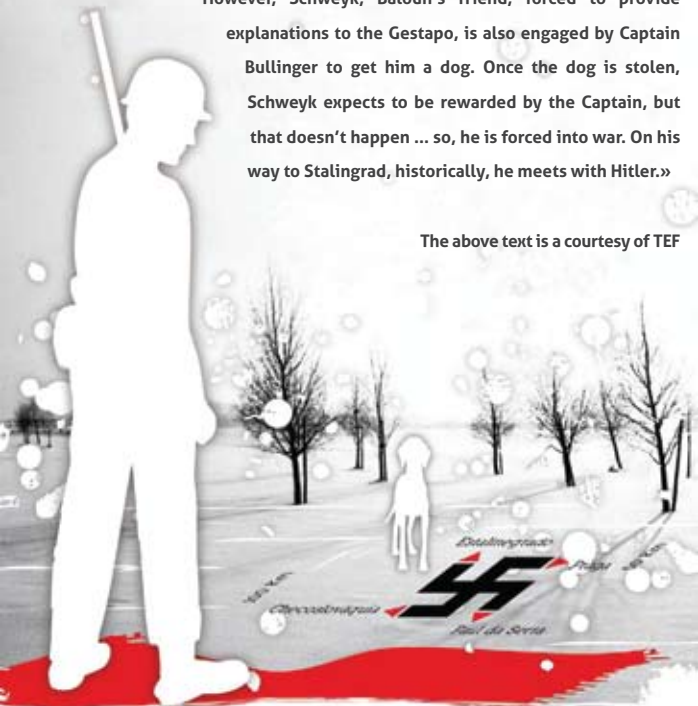
All over the world Theatre is celebrated and Madeira is no exception, with several companies producing events to mark this special day.

We suggest the new play by TEF, "Schweyk in the Second World War" by Bertolt Brecht, as from March 30 to April 15 at the Santo-Antonio movie theatre.

«Baloun, a customer of Kopecka, the owner d' O Cálice, desperate with a sense of deprivation, expresses his willingness to enlist in the German army, where soldiers are apparently well fed. Prochazka, who's in love with Kopecka, offers to get her a piece of meat and by taking the risk of violating the "war effort" he would be proving his love for Kopecka. Thus there was no need for Baloun to enroll and would remain a "good Czech.»

However, Schweyk, Baloun's friend, forced to provide explanations to the Gestapo, is also engaged by Captain Bullinger to get him a dog. Once the dog is stolen, Schweyk expects to be rewarded by the Captain, but that doesn't happen ... so, he is forced into war. On his way to Stalingrad, historically, he meets with Hitler.»
