“Começar a Acabar”



Directed and interpreted by João Lagarto, with music by Jorge Palma, “Começar a Acabar” or “Beginning to End” is a surprising dramaturgical production by Samuel Beckett that recalls the most significant moments of his work - “Molloy”, “Malone Dies” and “The Unnamable”. For João Lagarto, “Beginning to End” is, above all, a profound act of friendship between two distinguished Irishmen: the dramatist Samuel Beckett and the actor Jack Macgowran, which resulted in a monologue with an amazing dramatic unity. It’s a celebration of the self-contraction thematic and acknowledgment of Beckett’s quote: “Nothing is funnier than unhappiness; it’s the most comical thing in the world”.

The play will be on stage on the 15th and 16th of March at the Centre of Arts – Casa das Mudas.

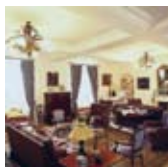
